Industry of the Ordinary: Adam Brooks and Mathew Wilson "Things have been going pretty well," says Adam Brooks, one half of Industry of the Ordinary. At Los Angeles MoCA's Allan Kaprow show, they staged "Re-Work" in which Hollywood sex workers were engaged at their nightly rates to paint a hallway as they wished, redoing Kaprow's "Work" from 1969. The collective has been busy with many other projects, including one at the College of DuPage in Glen Ellyn, in which oxygen tents were tintured with celebrity scents, and a permanent work has been installed at the Wicker Park/Bucktown Library.
